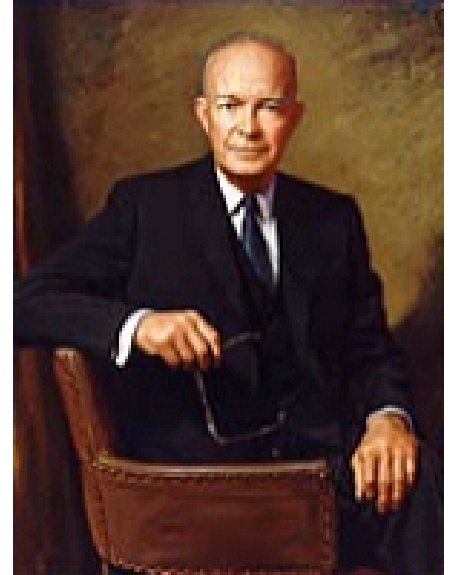


**Dwight David Eisenhower
Hispanic Serving Institution (HSI)
Transportation Fellowship Program at
The University of Texas at San Antonio**



- Intended for students who plan on entering the transportation-related profession
- Recipients must agree to develop a transportation-related project during the period of award

Amount: All stipends are taxable

- Junior or Senior Level: Up to \$1,450/month
- Masters Level: Up to \$1,700/month
- Doctoral Level: Up to \$2,000/month

Eligibility Criteria:

- Non-U.S. citizens *must* attach a copy of their I-20 ID or I-551 issued by the U.S. Immigration & Naturalization Service (INS).
- Must be a full-time degree seeking junior, senior, or graduate student
- Must be in a field of study directly related to transportation

HSI Fellowships will be awarded based on merit including:

- Academic standing, GPA, and official University transcripts
- Recommendations regarding the applicant's qualifications. (4 letters required)
- Transportation work experience, if any, including employer's endorsement; and
- Proposed plan of study
