COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIPS

All scholarships awarded by the College of Engineering require the recipient to:

- Be actively pursuing a degree in the College of Engineering and in good academic standing with the University
- Be enrolled as an Engineering major
- Be enrolled as a full-time student (12 semester credit hours for undergraduate students and 9 semester credit hours for graduate students)
- Meet any other requirements as stated in the scholarship criteria listed below

Award amounts are generally divided equally between the two semesters; and students must meet grade and enrollment requirements to receive the remainder of the award.

All applicants must complete a College of Engineering General Scholarship Application or the application specific to the scholarship and provide required narratives, resumes (see individual scholarship listings).

The following is a list of College of Engineering scholarships. These scholarships may change at any time and many are dependent upon renewed funding.

AMERICAN CONCRETE INSTITUTE SCHOLARSHIP

Award: Number and amount of award varies

- Must be a full-time student
- Must have upper-division status in civil engineering (60 semester credit hours in engineering program)
- Must have a minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA

Application requirements: COE General Scholarship application

AMERICAN SOCIETY OF CIVIL ENGINEERS, SAN ANTONIO BRANCH SCHOLARSHIP

Award: Number and amount of award varies

- Must be a full-time student (minimum of 12 credit hours) at UTSA
- Must have upper-division status (junior standing) in civil engineering
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5

Application requirements: COE General Scholarship application (please mark ASCE Scholarship) and a letter describing financial needs, future ambitions, previous awards, and participation in community and civic affairs

AMRATLAL M. PATEL ENGINEERING MEMORIAL ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

Award: One award of \$500 a year

- Must be pursuing a degree in electrical engineering offered by UTSA
- Must be enrolled full time as a graduate student (minimum of 9 credit hours) or undergraduate student (minimum of 12 credit hours)
- Undergraduate students must have a minimum 3.25 GPA (entering freshmen must have an SAT score of at least 1100 or an ACT score of at least 20); current graduate students must have a minimum 3.7 GPA and a GRE score of at least 1150 (verbal and quantitative)

Application requirements: COE Competitive Scholarship application

ANJU RAI MEMORIAL ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

Award: Number and amount of award varies

- Must be enrolled full time
- Must be pursuing a degree in electrical engineering offered by UTSA
- Students must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and demonstrated achievement in electrical engineering coursework; freshman applicants must have a minimum SAT score of 1000 and/or a minimum ACT score of 21 and have graduated in the top 25 percent of their high school class

Application requirement: COE General Scholarship application

ANSHUL SHARMA MEMORIAL ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

Award: Number and amount of award varies

- Must be enrolled on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 credit hours) as an undergraduate student or on a full-time basis (minimum 9 credit hours) as a graduate student actively pursuing a degree at UTSA
- Entering freshmen must have an SAT score of at least 900 or an ACT score of at least 20. Applicants who are current undergraduate students must have a minimum GPA of 2.5. Current graduate students must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale).
- Preference given to applicants from India
- Preference given to a student majoring in electrical engineering

Application requirements: COE General Scholarship application and one-page letter stating your career plans and how this award will help you in achieving your educational and career goals

ASME DESIGN EXCELLENCE GRADUATE COMPETITIVE SCHOLARSHIP

Award: Number and amount of award varies

- Must be a graduate student pursuing MS degree in Mechanical Engineering at UTSA
- Must be full-time (minimum of 9 semester credit hours) or working on masters thesis if course work is completed
- Minimum 3.0 GPA in graduate coursework or minimum 3.0 GPA in last 60 hours completed as an undergraduate
- Student member of ASME

Application requirements: Completed COE Competitive Scholarship Application. Letter or essay of approximately 500 words, stating area on interest, role Mechanical Engineering plays in career plans, activities in ASME or similar engineering organization.

Provide ASME membership number or proof of application for membership

ASME – SAN ANTONIO UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

Award: Number and amount of award varies

- Must be a junior or senior in mechanical engineering and a student member of ASME
- Must demonstrate merit through GPA, commitment to engineering profession and achievement
- Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident

Application requirements: ASME application and 500-word essay

EARL C. DAVIS SCHOLARSHIP BILLY MITCHESS CHAPTER OF OLD CROWS

Award: One award of \$1,500 a year

- Must be majoring in electrical engineering
- Must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA
- Must demonstrate financial need as determined by the UTSA Office of Student Financial Aid
- Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident

Application requirements: COE General Scholarship application

MORRIS PITMAN ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

Award: Number and amount of award varies

- Must be a full-time engineering student
- Must have completed 30 hours and have a minimum 2.8 GPA
- Must demonstrate financial need as determined by the UTSA Office of Student Financial Aid
- Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident

Application requirements: COE General Scholarship application and one-page statement

**MR. AND MRS. MILTON BERRY CIVIL
ENGINEERING ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP**

Award: Number and amount of award varies

- Must be majoring in civil engineering
- Must demonstrate high academic achievement
- Must have completed at least 60 hours

Application requirements: COE General Scholarship application and one-page statement

NORTH LOOP 410 ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

Award: Number and amount of award varies

- Must be pursuing an undergraduate degree in engineering
- Must be enrolled as a full-time student
- Must have a minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA; incoming freshmen must have been in the top 10 percent of their graduating class

Application requirements: COE General Scholarship application

**NORTH SAN ANTONIO CHAMBER OF COMMERCE
MAYOR LILA COCKRELL COE SCHOLARSHIP**

Award: Number and amount of award varies

- Must be undergraduate student in senior year majoring in Engineering
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Must demonstrate financial need as determined by the UTSA Office of Student Financial Aid

Application requirements: COE General Scholarship application and one-page letter stating career plans and how award will help achieve educational and career goals

PAPE-DAWSON ENGINEERS, INC. ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP

Award: Number and amount of award varies

- Undergraduate student majoring in Civil or Environmental Engineering at UTSA
- Must be enrolled for a minimum of 12 credit hours
- Must have a minimum 2.75 GPA and have completed at least 30 semester credit hours
- Must demonstrate leadership and community service by participation in student activities in the College of Engineering, University or community
- Must demonstrate financial need as determined by the UTSA Office of Student Financial Aid
- Preference will be given to U.S. citizens or permanent resident aliens who have graduated from a high school in Bexar County, Texas

Application requirements: COE General Scholarship application and letter of recommendation from faculty member or community leader familiar with the applicant

PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Award: Number and amount of award varies

- Must be enrolled on a full-time basis (12 semester credit hour for undergraduates and 9 for graduate students)
- Must be a current UTSA student with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Entering freshmen must demonstrate academic potential with minimum SAT score of 1090 and/or minimum ACT score of 24 and cumulative high school GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale

Application requirements: COE General Scholarship application and Biological Information Form

SAM MADRID, JR., ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

Award: Number and amount of award varies

- Applicant must be U.S. citizen
- Must be current UTSA student or incoming freshman for the fall semester
- Must have graduated from a San Antonio area high school
- Must have a “B” average in high school work and minimum 3.0 GPA in college work
- Must demonstrate financial need as determined by the UTSA Office of Student Financial Aid
- Must have declared a major in one of the following areas: Civil and Environmental Engineering, Electrical and Computer Engineering or Mechanical Engineering

Application requirements: Sam Madrid, Jr. Endowed Scholarship application

S. MOHUN MEMORIAL “PHOENIX” SCHOLARSHIP

Award: Number and amount of award varies

- Must be an undergraduate student
- Must be registered as a full time student (minimum of 12 credit hours) pursuing a degree in mechanical engineering and biomechanics in the College of Engineering at UTSA
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.2 (on a 4.0 scale) and must have successfully completed a minimum of 60 semester credit hours by the beginning of the fall semester
- The recipient will be selected by the official scholarship committee of the College of Engineering.

Application requirement: S. Mohun “Phoenix” Memorial Scholarship application

THOMAS B. AND KATHRYN MORROW ENGINEERING ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

Award: Number and amount of award varies

- Must be an undergraduate student pursuing an engineering degree at UTSA
- Must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours
- Must have a minimum 2.5 cumulative high school GPA or a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA in completed college coursework

Application requirements: COE General Scholarship application

USAA FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

Award: Number and amount of award varies

- May be incoming freshmen or undergraduate Engineering students with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Must be Engineering majors enrolled full-time with a minimum of 3 hours in the College of Engineering at the time of the award
- Must demonstrate financial need as determined by the UTSA Office of Student Financial Aid

Application requirements: COE General Scholarship application and a one-page letter stating career plans and how the award will help achieve educational and career goals.
