Multiple Faculty Positions in Electrical and Computer Engineering

The Electrical and Computer Engineering Department at The University of Texas at San Antonio invites applications for **an open-rank faculty** position in the area of computer and network security (wireless security, mobile and location-aware security, multimedia security and privacy, cryptography, intrusion detection and prevention, secure protocols, trusted computing architectures, security and virtualization), and **an open-rank faculty professor** position in the area of computer engineering (computer architecture, digital systems design using HDL, VLSI design, system on a chip, design synthesis and verification, field programmable gate arrays, embedded systems, or related areas), starting Spring 2009/Fall 2009 pending budget approval. **Required qualifications for the junior position** are Ph.D. in Electrical Engineering, Computer Engineering or related areas and the candidate should demonstrate research and teaching capability. **Responsibilities for the junior position** include research, teaching at the graduate and undergraduate levels, and program development including close collaboration with the newly formed UTSA Institute for Cyber-Security Research. **Required qualifications for the senior faculty position** are Ph.D. in Computer Engineering, Electrical Engineering, or related areas and an established teaching and research record. **Responsibilities for the senior position** include teaching at the graduate and undergraduate levels and developing funded research programs. Preference will be given to candidates with experience in program building and demonstrated ability to initiate collaborative and funded research.

The Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering offers the B.S., M.S., and Ph.D. degrees supporting a dynamic and growing program. The research activities and experimental facilities have been well-supported by various Federal research and infrastructure grants. See <http://engineering.utsa.edu> for details.

Applicants must submit a letter of application that identifies the position they are applying for and the rank of the position. Applications must also include a curriculum vitae, indicate the status of citizenship, a statement of research plan, a statement of teaching plan, and the names, addresses (postal and e-mail), and telephone numbers of at least three references. Applicants who are selected for interviews must be able to show proof that they are eligible and qualified to work in the United States. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
