Senior Lecturer in Mechanical Engineering

Nominations and applications are solicited for one Senior Lecturer position. This is a Non-Tenure Track (NTT) position. We are looking for a motivated educator to help the Mechanical Engineering Department maintain its quality undergraduate program. Senior lecturers typically teach four undergraduate or graduate courses per semester and advise several undergraduate students. Senior Lecturers do not have any research duties. The successful candidate will be expected to start in the Fall 2008 semester pending budget approval.

Required qualifications: A Masters or Ph.D. degree in Mechanical Engineering or a closely related discipline.

UTSA, with currently over 28,000 students, is a federally designated minority serving university and is the second largest university within the UT System. In the last three years, UTSA has tripled the number of Ph.D. Degree Programs and is expanding its research base. The Mechanical Engineering Department (with an enrollment of over 600 undergraduate and graduate students) is dynamic and growing. The Department anticipates the establishment of a Ph.D. degree program in Mechanical Engineering, late in 2008 or early in 2009. New campus facilities include the \$83 million, 225,000 sq. ft., Biotechnology, Science and Engineering Building which was completed in 2005, and a 150,000 sq. ft. Engineering Building, which will open in 2010. Academic and research interactions exist with higher education and research institutions in San Antonio, specifically, the University of Texas Health Science Center (Medical and Dental schools) and Southwest Research Institute.

All applicants must send a cover letter, a current curriculum vitae and names and addresses of three references. Applicants who are not U.S. citizens must clearly state their current visa and residency status. The search committee may request letters of recommendation from additional references for the candidates on the short list.
