The successful candidate must have a significant record of leading publications, a very strong research funding record that includes funding from federal agencies, an excellent international reputation, an excellent educational record and outstanding communication skills to represent the College of Engineering and ICARE on campus and in the community. **The expected start date is Fall of 2009 pending budget approval.**
