

## **FACULTY POSITION IN MECHANICAL ENGINEERING:**

The Department of Mechanical Engineering at the University of Texas San Antonio (UTSA) has one position to be filled by January 2010. We are recruiting to sustain the growth of an expanding department. Applications at the ranks of Assistant or Associate Professor in all areas of Mechanical Engineering are sought. We will hire an outstanding, innovative, and dynamic individual with a Ph.D. in Mechanical Engineering or a closely related field and who can help the department strengthen its teaching and research programs. Preference will be given to candidates in the areas of Energy Conversion, Renewable Energy and Thermo-Fluid Sciences.

The successful candidate must be able to support the teaching mission of the Department and build a successful, externally funded research program. This candidate must be able to develop and teach innovative courses, supervise graduate students, obtain funding for their research programs, and communicate their research results in quality Journals and Conferences. Interdisciplinary activities in research and teaching and interactions with the other departments within the College of Engineering are highly encouraged. Recent Ph.D. candidates with a strong commitment to research are particularly encouraged to apply for the position at the Assistant Professor level. Candidates for Associate Professor must have proven research records and significant extramural funding.

UTSA is located on the northwest side of San Antonio, Texas. San Antonio is a vibrant city of more than 1.5 million people, with significant economic growth, numerous industrial establishments and excellent school districts. The city and the University provide excellent cultural and educational opportunities as well as exceptional employment opportunities for spouses. The University has more than 28,000 students and is now the second largest component in the University of Texas System. The College of Engineering at UTSA was established in 2000 and currently houses four departments. The ME Department has a projected faculty of 25+ with programs at the bachelors and masters levels. A doctoral program is expected to be initiated in Fall 2010.
